• Sturgeon Public School Division has a Conflict Resolution Procedure called <u>Focused and</u> <u>Effective Communication</u>. This is an interest-based dispute resolution approach for dealing with communication and challenges between internal and external stakeholders.

The success of all students is the guiding principle for all dispute resolution at the school and division level. When differences of opinion occur, the most effective method to achieve resolution is direct communication between the parties involved.
